Auditions: September 26-27 Callbacks: September 28-29

(Optional Practice Audition Day: September 25)

Here's what you can expect at your audition for *Radium Girls*:

What to prepare: You'll need to prepare a 1-2 minute monologue. You can find monologues online, in movies/plays, or in monologue books. Choose a monologue that resonates with you and showcases your acting range. Practice and memorize it to the best of your ability.

Optional Practice Audition Day (September 25): There will be a practice audition day before the official auditions. This day is designed to be a low-stakes environment where you can perform your monologue and receive feedback from Mr. Koppel and Hannah. While not mandatory, it is highly recommended.

The Audition (September 26-27): You'll be given an audition form to fill out with your contact information and any experience you have. Stay calm and focused; remember, everyone is there to support you and we are rooting for you. When it's your turn, take a deep breath and confidently introduce yourself (example: Hi, my name is ____ and this monologue is from _play title_ by _author_). Then, perform your memorized monologue.

Callbacks (September 28-29): After auditions, please keep an eye on your email for a callback list. You may be given lines for a specific character to read. We don't expect or require these lines to be memorized, but it's a good idea to familiarize yourself with them.

Tips for Success:

- It is helpful to choose a monologue that fits the tone and themes of *Radium Girls*. Ask Mr. Koppel for a copy of the script.
- Focus on delivering your monologue with emotion and authenticity. Don't rush through it.
- Be open to feedback during the practice audition day. It's a learning opportunity.
- On audition day be supportive of other auditionees.
- Be flexible during callbacks. We may ask you to read for different characters.
